SRI PANCHAMUKHA HANUMAT SAKTIPATA
MOOLA MANTRA AKSHARA LAKSHA
JAPASAHITA MAHA YAGNAM



Starting on January 22, 2022 until January 2023 we are planning to perform Panchamukha Hanumath Yagnam. Through the whole year, we will be chanting the moola mantras 600,000 times. We will also be chanting Hanuman Chalisa parayanam 460,000 times for the whole year.

We will collect dravyams from the following Prasiddha Punya Hanuman Kshetrams.

1. *Himalaya Sanjeevani Parvatam*
2. *Ramasethu*
3. *Anjanadri Parvatam*
4. *Japali Anjaneya Kshetram in Tirumala*
5. *Hanumangadhi Ayodhya*

“We will collect panchadhatus from all the above Pavitra sthalams, Make Panchamukhi Hanuman Moorthy with panchaloha and perform the Maha Yagnam with Pavithra Pooja Dravyams”.

How does Panchamukha Anjaneya look:

Panchamukha Hanuman took his form as 5 components (Amsas) of Lord Vishnu. Details of five faces.

East face: Hanuman himself. Cleanses sins and gives purity of mind (Chitta Suddhi)

South face: Karaala Ugra Narasimha Swamy: Relieves fear of enemy and helps to gain victory.

West face: Mahaa Veera Garuda Swamy: Removes Harmful forces and protects from poisonous elements.

North Face: Lakshmi Varaha Murthy: Protects from bad effects of Grahas and Blesses with Ashtaiswaryas.

Urdhwa Mukham: Hayagriva Swamy: Bestows people with Wisdom, Victory and appropriate life partner and children.

Legend behind the formation of five faces:

According to Myraavana's story, as the fierce battle ensued between Rama and Raavana, and Raavana's forces dwindled and his son Indrajit also got killed, Raavana was surprised that his expectations of easily defeating Rama in battle because Rama is a human being and his army is Vaanaraas was totally wrong, and afraid and scared for the first time. So, he sought help of his relative Myraavana, the king of Paataala Lokam.

Realising that danger is lurking for safety of Rama and Lakshmana, Hanuman created powerful safety net for them. Still Myraavana was able to break the safety net and steals Rama and Lakshmana and takes them to Paataala Lokam. Hanuman makes his next move and reaches Paataalam. He encounters Makaradhwaja, a strange looking life form guarding Myraavana's kingdom. Hanuman recognises that he is his own son, born from his body sweat to a Jalakanya. But he realises his duty and gets into an intense battle with Makaradhwaja and at last, gains upper hand and enters into Myraavana's Raajyam.

He fights with Myraavana but soon understands that he has to put out all five Deepas in five directions, North, south, east, west and up, all at the same time, otherwise he cannot kill Myraavana. So, he transforms into five faces in five directions and puts off all the Deepas at the same time. Along with five faces, he has Ten arms that hold weapons like sword, Trishul, Gada and such and kills Myraavana and rescues Rama and Lakshmana. From that time, he has been Worshipped as PANCHAMUKHA AANJANEYA.

Piousness of Panchamukha Hanuman: Best described in Kambha Ramayana, he is personification of Pancha Bhootas, Vaayu, Water, Sky, Earth and Agni are incorporated in him

There are 5 forms of expression of Bhakti, Chanting Name, thinking in mind with concentration, Keertanam, Pleading and Arpanam. He worships Lord Rama in all 5 forms of Bhakti
